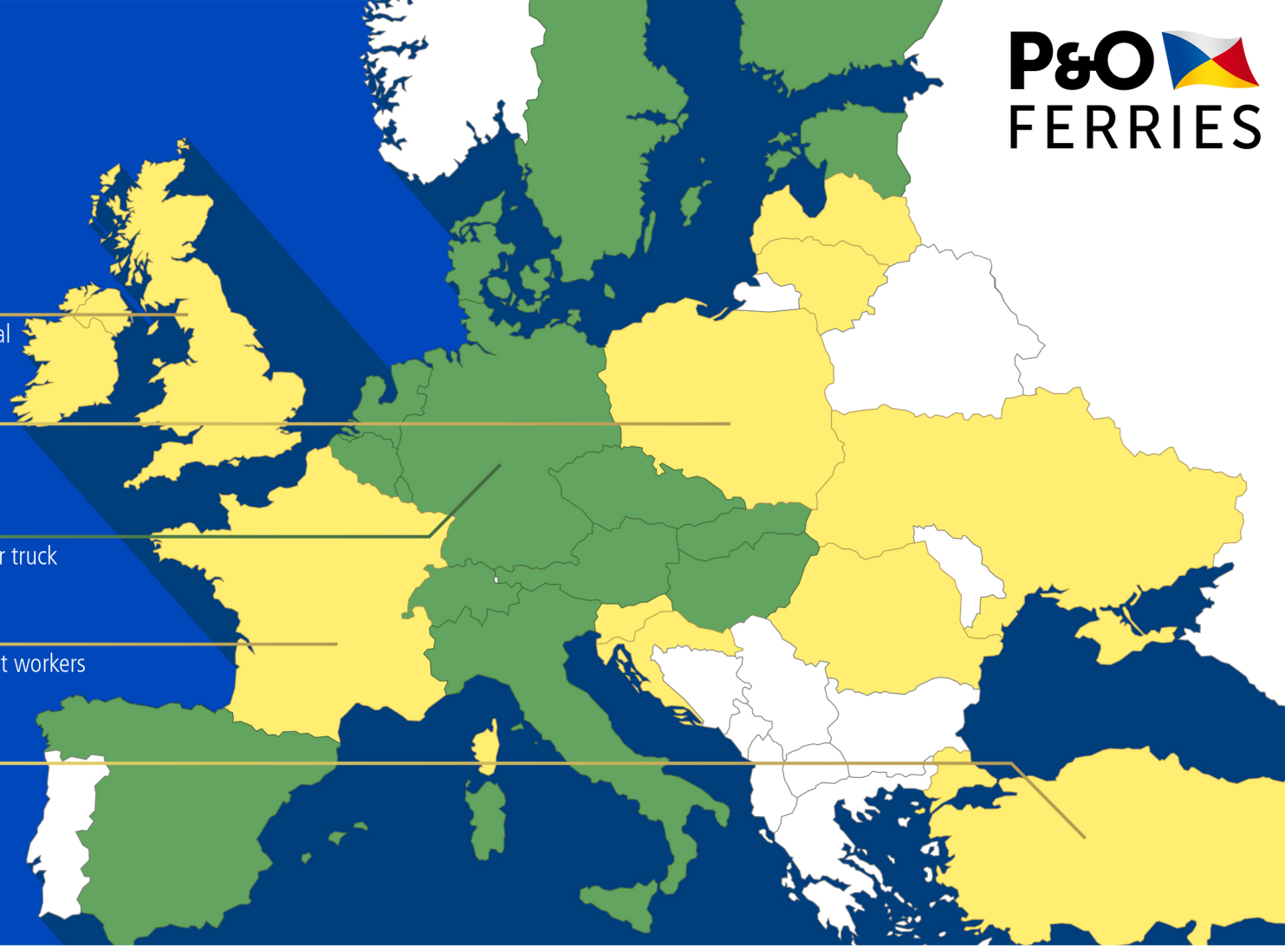


COVID-19 TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS AT EUROPEAN BORDER CROSSINGS

Requirement for Drivers to complete a form on or before arrival

POLAND

Drivers should wear face masks when outside of their truck

GERMANY

Recommendation that drivers wear face masks outside of their truck

FRANCE

Driver only needs to carry Certificate for International transport workers

TURKEY

Foreign drivers should commit to exiting Turkey as soon as possible (72 hours restriction lifted)
